PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under the direction of the Project Coordinators, the Peer Outreacher is a member of a team of individuals who outreach to and support other individuals with hoarding and cluttering challenges. The Peer Hoarding and Cluttering Outreach Team is a new initiative of the Mental Health Association.

POSITION OPPORTUNITIES:

- As part of the Peer Outreach Team, provide support and referrals to other individuals dealing with hoarding challenges.
- Assist individuals with setting goals in their recovery process with an emphasis on harm reduction and empowerment.
- Actively participate as a team member in weekly planning, training, and case conferencing meetings.
- Co-facilitate peer-led support groups.
- Assist the Project Coordinators with community presentations to non-profit partners, city departments, mental health consumers, and community groups; this often includes sharing your personal story of recovery.
- Maintain records, spreadsheets, and logs of activities.
- Other duties as assigned by Project Coordinator.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Lived personal experience with hoarding and cluttering challenges and commitment to recovery model.
- Empathy, good judgment, and the ability to share your personal story of recovery.
- Collaborative team working style with ability to relate effectively with people from diverse backgrounds.
- Sensitivity to consumer's confidentiality.
- Commitment to consumer empowerment, culturally competent services, and nonjudgmental harm reduction approach.
- Organized, resourceful, and able to multi-task and manage time well.
